## WALK

Living at The Rylan means it is easier than ever to get out of traffic and get around on foot. Enjoy a short walk to the Metro, discover nearby trails and walking paths, or head to Capital One Center across the street – you won't have to go far to find your favorite spot. Ditch your car and discover all your neighborhood has to offer on foot!

## METRO

McLean Metro Station on the Silver line is half a mile away from The Rylan, unlocking all that the D.C. Metro area offers. Event in D.C.? Dinner with friends in Arlington? Hop on the Metro for a quick ride, escape traffic, and be driven where you need to go.

## CARPOOL

Carpooling makes it easier than ever to leave your car at home while you save time, reduce commuting stress, and save money on gas, tolls, and vehicle wear-and-tear. Joining a carpool means that you can take advantage of the HOV lanes on Dulles Toll Road, ride on I-66 inside the beltway for free, and enjoy on the Express Lanes on I-495, I-395, and I-95, for free, as well.

## GUARANTEED RIDE HOME

Guaranteed Ride Home is a service for commuters in the D.C. Metro area who regularly carpool, bike, walk, or take public transit to work with a free and reliable ride home when an immediate means of transportation is necessary. The program is designed as a safety net when one of life's unexpected emergencies arise. Commuters may take advantage of Guaranteed Ride Home up to four times per year to get home for unexpected emergencies, such as staying overtime at work, a personal illness, or a sick child.

The Rylan is in close proximity to several bus routes that connect you to places throughout your immediate community in McLean and beyond. All Fairfax Connector rides are only \$2.00 per trip, and they are often free when connecting to another bus or discounted when getting on the Metro after your trip.

## BIKE

Biking is a great way to get around McLean and beyond. With hundreds of miles of trails located in Fairfax County, finding bike-friendly routes fit to your skill and adventure level will never be an issue. It's never been easier to enjoy McLean on two wheels (even if you don't have your own bike). A Capital Bikeshare station is just down the street at the McLean Metro Station. Renting a bikeshare is simple and rides under 30 minutes are entirely free of charge.

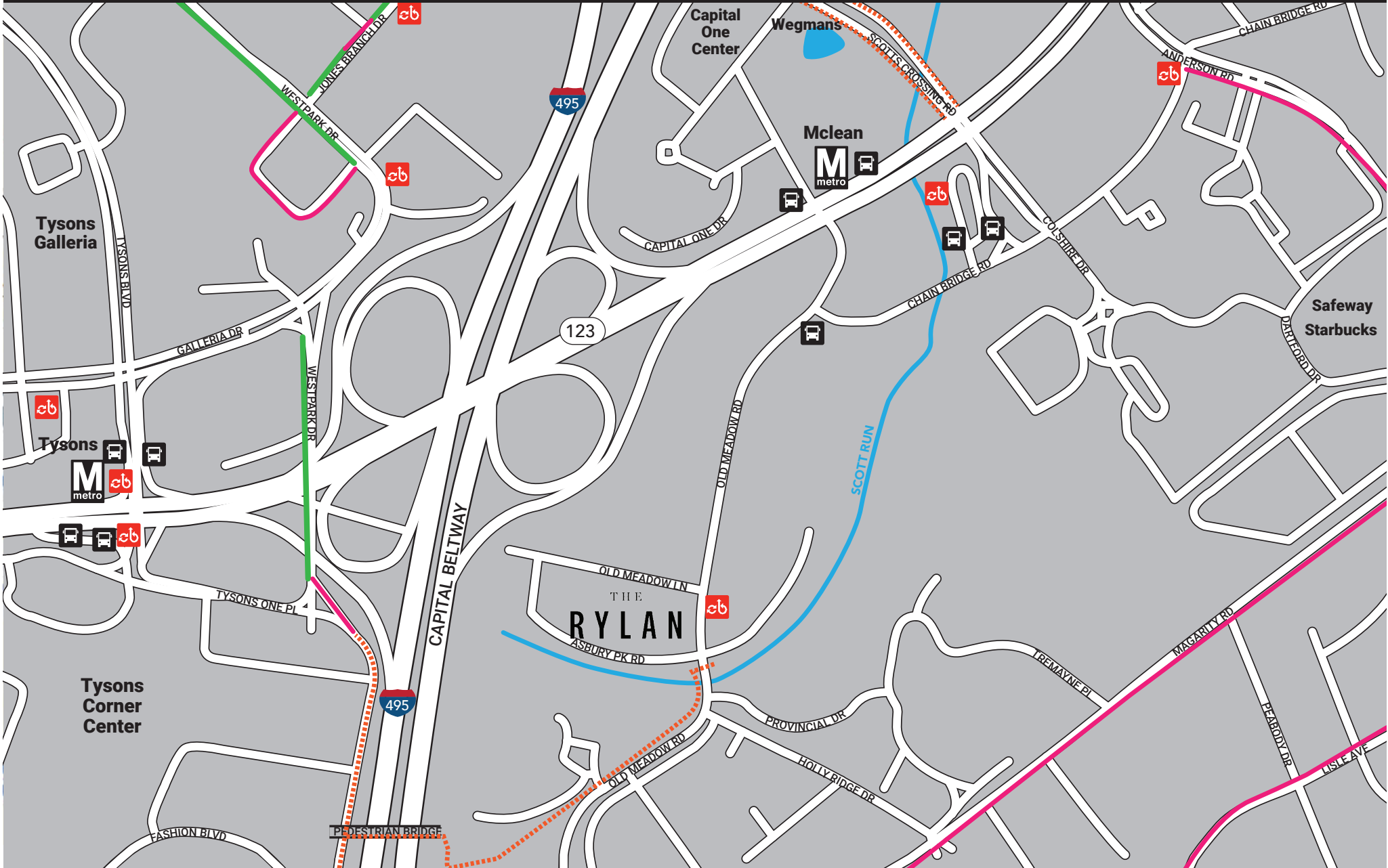
